6th Grade Families – Students who currently have Middle School Orientation will be moving to a new class for second semester. Some students will be staying with Ms. Dusbabek for Reading Intervention based on their test scores and teacher recommendations. Students not needing reading intervention will have a choice between AVID, Spanish, and French. Ms. Gates will be meeting with these students in December and January to help make a course selection. AVID: AVID stands for Advancement via Individual Determination and is a class offered to students who would like to prepare for four-year universities by strengthening academic skills. Students will have the opportunity to apply for the AVID program as a 2nd semester class after they have taken Middle School Orientation.

Spanish – 6th grade students will have the opportunity to take a 2nd semester beginning Spanish class after Middle School Orientation. Students will explore foundational vocabulary, basic communication skills, and Spanish culture.

French – 6th grade students will have the opportunity to take a 2nd semester beginning French class after Middle School Orientation. Students will explore foundational vocabulary, basic communication skills, and French culture.
